

ORDINANCE 2001-3

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL NEW WATER USERS TO INSTALL AND BE RESPONSIBLE FOR A PRESSURE REGULATOR AND SHUT OFF VALVE LOCATED ON EACH METER, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the city of Pottsville has applied and been approved for a water improvement project; and,

WHEREAS, upon the completion of the project the water pressure will dramatically increase in the Pottsville Water System; and,

WHEREAS, the customers of the Pottsville Water System, in order to protect their pipes and home due to the added pressure, should have installed a pressure regulator and shut off valve.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POTTSVILLE, POPE COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. After passage of this Ordinance all new Pottsville water customers will be responsible for the installation of a pressure regulator and shut off valve located at the meter.

Section 2. That the pressure regulator and shut off valve shall be installed before any water service is turned on by the City or the meter is installed and the pressure regulator and shut off valve shall comply with all Arkansas plumbing code guidelines and approved by the water and sewer department of the city of Pottsville.

Section 3. Emergency Clause. An emergency is hereby declared and this Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, the protection of water customers' pipes and possessions in their home, and for the health and safety of the system's users shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
