

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-06

AN ORDINANCE TO "OPT OUT" OF THE SHIELDED OUTDOOR LIGHTING ACT AS SET OUT IN A.C.A. 8-14-104

WHEREAS, it appears to the Council of the city of Pottsville, Arkansas, that the city of Pottsville should elect to "opt out" of the Shielded Outdoor Lighting Act. That at the most recent Legislative Session the Legislature passed A.C.A. 8-14-104 which states, in part, that "no public funds shall be used to install an outdoor lighting fixture unless it is shielded", and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the city of Pottsville has determined that the cost of acquiring a shielded outdoor lighting fixture would be prohibitive after comparing the cost of the fixtures and the projected energy costs of the operation of the fixtures.

NOW, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POTTSVILLE, ARKANSAS:

1. That the City Council has determined that the costs of acquiring shielded outdoor lighting fixtures would be prohibitive after the council has compared the costs of the fixtures and the projected energy costs of the operation of the fixtures, and therefore, by way of this Ordinance, elect to "opt out" of that requirement in A.C.A. 8-14-104.
