

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-4

**AN ORDINANCE ADDRESSING PERSONS WHO DRIVE A VEHICLE IN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF POTTSVILLE IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO INDICATE A DISREGARD TO THE SAFETY OF PERSONS OR PROPERTY.**

**WHEREAS**, the city of Pottsville has an interest in protecting citizens and property within the city limits of the city of Pottsville.

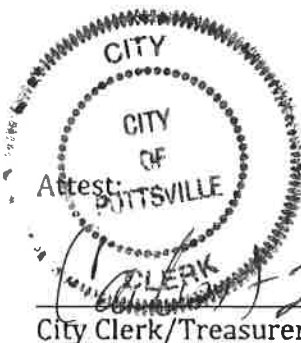
**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POTTSVILLE, ARKANSAS, OF THE FOLLOWING:**


Section 1. That it shall be illegal for any person to drive any vehicle in the city limits of Pottsville in such a manner as to indicate a disregard to the safety of persons or property. Anyone guilty of this behavior is guilty of this Ordinance titled Hazardous or Unsafe Driving.

Section 2. That any person convicted of hazardous or unsafe driving shall be punished upon a first conviction with a fine not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and no more than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).

Section 3. Emergency Clause. This ordinance being necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Pottsville, Arkansas, based upon the reasons stated above, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
