

ORDINANCE NO. 82- 1

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING ALL CRIMINAL STATUTES OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS RELATING TO MISDEMEANOR AND VIOLATIONS AS PART OF THE LAWS OF THE CITY OF POTTSVILLE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Pottsville has no judicial system and is desirous of establishing one;

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the City, in order to have a judicial system, adopt certain statutes of the State of Arkansas.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Pottsville as follows:

SECTION 1.: State Criminal Statutes Adopted. All criminal statutes of the State relating to misdemeanors and violations and the laws of criminal procedure in connection therewith, three (3) copies of which are on file in the Clerk/Treasurer's Office, are hereby enacted by the City Council to form a part of the laws of the City and any person, firm or corporation being found guilty of the violation of any such laws shall be deemed guilty of the violation of the ordinances of the City, and shall be fined or imprisoned or both in the manner set out under the State Statutes.

SECTION 2.: State Penalties Adopted. The same minimum and maximum penalties for the violation of misdemeanors and violations as are provided in the State Statutes are hereby adopted as the minimum and maximum fines for the violation of the same offenses which are prohibited by the Ordinances of this City.

SECTION 3.: This Ordinance being necessary for the

public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage.
